Strictly Necessary Cookies

We currently use only strictly necessary cookies, which are essential for the operation, security and performance of our website. These cookies enable core functionality such as security, network management, and accessibility. Under the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 (SI 2003/2426) (PECR), consent is not required for the essential cookies we use.

hs	This cookie is essential for our site and used for security Cookie for Hive(legacy). This cookie last for a single browsing session.
svSession	This cookie is essential for our site and used for security, stability, and core site function. This cookie last for 12 months.
SSR-caching	This cookie is essential for our site and used for performance cookie for rendering. This cookie last for 24 hours.
TS*	This cookie is essential for our site and used for attack detection. This cookie last for a single browsing session.

Analytical or Performance Cookies and Functionality Cookies

For transparency, and in anticipation of future enhancements, we also describe analytical/performance cookies and functionality cookies below. These categories are not currently in use on our website.

- 1. Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

2. **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
